



IAS CANDIDATE CRITERIA

PRESIDENT-ELECT: Elected candidate would take on the "President-Elect" position in January 2019, followed by a three-year term as **President** (January 2022-December 2024).

Present incumbent **is not** eligible for immediate re-election for a second term. There is no financial remuneration for this position.

- 1) The Candidate must be willing to serve for 3 years as President-Elect, followed by an additional 3 years as President.
- 2) S/he should be internationally well known and actively involved in the field of atherosclerosis and its related diseases.
- 3) S/he should be actively involved in IAS activities, at the international, regional or local levels.
- 4) S/he should be actively involved in other international or regional organizations with compatible missions, objectives, and goals.
- 5) S/he should be willing to reach out to other international or regional organizations in related fields, such as hypertension, diabetes, imaging, and metabolic disorders, etc.
- 6) S/he should have the ability, time, and desire to travel during his or her term to help develop new local societies and to promote the IAS, especially in but not limited to emerging regions.
- 7) S/he should have excellent connections with all potential sponsors at the international level.
- 8) S/he should have good communications and organizational skills.
- 9) S/he should be willing to devote his or her time and energy to the support and promotion of the IAS.

SECRETARY: Elected candidate would take on the position in January 2019, for a term of three years (January 2019-December 2021).
