Robert S. Rosenson, MD, is Professor of Medicine at the Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, and Director of Cardiometabolic Disorders at Mount Sinai Heart, New York, New York. He received his medical degree at Tulane University, New Orleans, Louisiana, and went on to complete his residency in internal medicine at Brigham and Women's Hospital, Boston, Massachusetts, followed by a fellowship in cardiology at The University of Chicago, Chicago, Illinois.

Dr Rosenson is a Fellow of the American Heart Association (AHA) Council on Arteriosclerosis, Thrombosis, and Vascular Biology, and the AHA Council on Epidemiology and Prevention. He is also a Fellow of the American College of Cardiology and American College of Physicians. Dr Rosenson has long been an active member of the National Lipid Association and has served on its board of directors, program development committee, and expert panels. He has served as principal investigator (PI) on a number of studies funded by the National Institutes of Health, pharmaceutical-sponsored drug trials, and multicenter studies. Dr Rosenson was Global PI of the PLASMA I, PLASMA II, and FRANCIS trials. He is the recipient of numerous awards and honors, including the Ground-Breaking Doctors Award from *Chicago* magazine, and was named New York Top Doc from 2015-2018. For three consecutive years, Dr Rosenson was named recipient of the Simon Dack Award for outstanding scholarship by the *Journal of the American College of Cardiology*. The International Academy of Cardiology honored him with the Jan J. Kellerman Memorial Award in 2016 for distinguished contributions in the field of cardiovascular disease prevention. In 2017, UpToDate recognized him for 20 years of Outstanding Contributions as Editor.

His ongoing research interests include the effects of novel lipid-lowering therapy, inflammation, thrombogenesis, and rheology. Dr Rosenson's more recent interests extend to selective inhibitors of inflammatory pathways. He has authored more than 300 journal articles published in peer-reviewed journals. In addition, he has written 700 book chapters and abstracts, as well as electronic publications for UpToDate Medicine. Dr Rosenson is co-Editor in Chief for *Cardiovascular Drugs and Therapy*, Section Editor on Metabolic Disorders for the *Journal of the American College of Cardiology*, and Section Editor on Lipid Disorders for *UpToDate*.
